



Am I ready to prepare for my Confirmation?

- Do I go to Mass weekly?
- Do I go to Mass willingly and participate in the Liturgy?
- Do I pray regularly?
- Does my behavior reflect that I follow Christ?
- Do I have an interest in learning more about my Catholic faith?
- Am I willing to talk about my faith with my peers?
- Do I want to be a fully participating member of my faith community?
- Am I willing to accept my responsibility in fulfilling the requirements to prepare for Confirmation, including:
 - Attending all six Monday night preparation sessions
 - Attending the Confirmation retreat
 - Completing at least 5 ministry service hours
 - Completing at least 5 social justice service hours
 - Completing at least 5 community service hours
 - Completing a Reflection on Service form for all service hours
 - Adhering to all deadlines
 - Writing a letter to the Bishop conferring the Sacrament
- Am I willing to make Confirmation preparation a priority in my life?
- Have I talked about this commitment with my parents and do they support me in this decision?

If you answered YES to these questions, then you are probably ready to make the commitment to be Confirmed at St. Mark! How exciting! So, now what?
